



Earn college credit for your EF Gap program

You can earn three college credits each for select program modules. You can also earn a university-level certificate for your gap year.

Enhance your EF gap experience by enrolling in one of the following course programs offered through our innovative educational partner, Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU). Complete advanced coursework. Refine your academic goals. Build a professional resume. Students who attend these courses routinely find they are more prepared for college success, are better positioned to take on campus, community, and leadership roles, and have a better understanding of what the professional world values.

INDIVIDUAL COURSES

SNHU offers individual courses for credit that correspond with the following EF Gap Year or Gap Semester program modules: Language Study, Service Learning, and Internship. You can earn three semester hours of general credit each for any or all of these modules in your program. Your own firsthand experiences abroad form the basis for the coursework you complete. You connect with your SNHU professor via email or Skype at key points during each module to discuss how you have been thinking, reading, and writing about those experiences, complete assignments, and develop a final project that explores a topic related to the course theme. translate your hands-on experience, research activity, and continuous self-reflection into usable outcomes such as language fluency, community action, and business knowledge.

EF GLOBAL SCHOLARS CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

EF Gap Year students have the additional option of earning a university-level certificate from SNHU. You can combine individual courses for your Language Study, Service Learning, and Internship modules—for a total of 9 semester hours of credit—and then complete an additional capstone project that explores a key aspect of global citizenship. Throughout your gap year, you connect periodically via email or Skype with your SNHU professor to complete assignments and create a final project that translates your hands-on EF Gap Year experiences, research activity, new knowledge, and continuous self-reflection into an authentic contribution to the conversation about global citizenship. This is a unique opportunity to engage in college-level coursework, build your professional resume—as well as see the world, yourself, and your passions more clearly. On successful completion of the program, you can request a letter of recommendation from your professor. You can even be considered for preferred admission to a degree program at SNHU.

HOW TO ENROLL

As soon as you are fully enrolled on your EF Gap program, you can speak with an EF Gap Consultant about which courses make the most sense for you. FINANCIAL AID OPTIONS

You may be able to use funds in your 529 savings plan to pay for expenses associated with your EF Gap experience. But be sure to check with your financial advisor beforehand, as rules vary by state. Only students who are enrolled in a full-time degree program at SNHU and taking courses recognized as degree requirements may be eligible to use Pell Grants or subsidized or unsubsidized federal loans.
